


9 out of 10 homes in the U.S. are under-insulated.* **Climb into your attic and measure the insulation level** to see what work can be done to take control of your high utility bills this heating season and increase your home's comfort.

1. Measure

Go into your attic and use a measuring tape or ruler to **measure the depth of the insulation** in inches. Looking across your attic, if the insulation is level with or below the attic floor joists, you probably need to **add more insulation**.




2. Get Solutions
