

## DEAR MANUFACTURED HOUSING STAKEHOLDERS.

In response to the release of the more stringent Energy Conservation Standards for Manufactured Housing, EPA proposed a new version of the ENERGY STAR Manufactured Homes program requirements, which was initially referred to as Version 2.1 but is ultimately being titled Version 3. This email is to announce that EPA has finalized these proposals and appreciates the feedback provided by program partners and other stakeholders. The draft proposal, all comments submitted by stakeholders, and EPA's responses to comments are posted on the <u>ENERGY STAR stakeholder feedback</u> web page.

**EPA** has finalized the **ENERGY STAR** Manufactured Homes Version 3 program requirements.

Manufactured homes produced on or after May 31, 2023 must be certified using Version 3. The final Version 3 program requirements and further details on the implementation timeline are available on the ENERGY STAR program requirements web page.

Note that the ENERGY STAR Manufactured Homes program applies to homes built in a factory that are subject to the federal Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards contained in 24 CFR 3280. Modular homes, site-built single-family homes, and multifamily buildings can be certified through other ENERGY STAR Residential New Construction programs.
