

- Expect to see increases in existing and new home sales, home improvement product sales, and remodeling spending









State of the Appliance Market

ENERGY STAR unit shipments increased across multiple product categories









ENERGY SAVINGS

If all cluthes dryers sold in the United States were ENERGY STAR certified, the energy cost savings would grow to more than \$1.5 billion each year and 21 billion pounds of annual greenhouse gas emissions would be prevented, equivalent to the emissions from more than 2 million vehicles.

- Over the lifetime of the product, an ENERGY STAR certified clothes dryer saves 1,500 kWh, more than 1 million BTUs of natural gas, and \$160 in energy bills.
- A full size electric ENERGY STAR certified clothes dryer saves 1,900 kWh of electricity and \$190 in energy bills over the lifetime of the product.
- A full size gas ENERGY STAR certified clothes dryer saves more than six million BTUs of natural gas and \$65 in energy bills over the next 12 years.
