
Families and businesses are saving with the help of ENERGY STAR®

Alaska is home to about **20** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

- 4** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
 - 1** company supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
 - 1** company building ENERGY STAR certified homes,
- as well as many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

Across Alaska

- 167 thousand customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2018
- 476 buildings** (almost 24 million square feet) were benchmarked in 2018 using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 11,856 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR
- 44 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency, including 31 schools, 4 hospitals, and 2 office buildings.
