District of Columbia is home to about **150** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

3 companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes

3 companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, 3 of which are committed to building 100% ENERGY STAR, as well as many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

Across District of Columbia

281 thousand customers were served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2018

2,747 buildings (more than 535 million square feet) were benchmarked in 2018 using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager

761 homes have earned the ENERGY STAR

425 buildings have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency, including 3 schools, 7 hotels, and 368 office buildings.

State Spotlights

Fannie Mae created extra incentives for owners of multifamily properties to earn ENERGY STAR certification by offering discounted interest rates on mortgages for those properties, and incorporating ENERGY STAR metrics into its standard forms and multifamily loan documents used for thousands of loans annually.

Twelve D.C. buildings competed in the 2016 ENERGY STAR 2016 Battle of the Buildings: BOOTCAMP, saving an **estimated \$124,905 in energy and water costs in just three months.**
