Families and businesses are saving with the help of ENERGY STAR®

Nebraska is home to about **80** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

- 2** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 4** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 19** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, 4 of which are committed to building 100% ENERGY STAR, as well as many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

Across Nebraska

- 1.1 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2018
- 1,200 buildings** (almost 115 million square feet) were benchmarked in 2018 using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 4,047 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR
- 141 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency, including 38 schools, 1 hotel, 3 hospitals, 45 office buildings and 2 industrial plants.

State Spotlights

The industrial plants in Nebraska that are ENERGY STAR certified have **saved a cumulative \$19 million in energy costs**.

The five Nebraska sites that achieved the ENERGY STAR Challenge for Industry **saved \$1,454,909 in energy costs**.

The **Boys & Girls Club of the Midlands**, located in Omaha, competed in the 2016 ENERGY STAR 2016 Battle of the Buildings: BOOTCAMP, **saving an estimated \$2,368 in energy costs** in just three months.
