Tennessee is home to about **210** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

- 24** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 25** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 57** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, 4 of which are committed to building 100% ENERGY STAR, as well as many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

Across Tennessee

- 8.6 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2018
- 3,988 buildings** (almost 342 million square feet) were benchmarked in 2018 using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 15,518 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR
- 461 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency, including 105 schools, 1 hotel, 6 hospitals, 122 office buildings and 8 industrial plants.

State Spotlights

Eastman Chemical Company, based in Kingsport, is a global specialty chemical company that manufactures a broad range of products found in everyday items. With help from ENERGY STAR, Eastman has **reduced energy intensity more than 10 percent** since 2008. Using the baseline energy intensity compared to current production at present energy prices, Eastman would have spent **\$36.3 million** more in 2016 on energy if the energy intensity had not changed since 2008.

Nissan North America, Inc., based in Franklin, achieved **more than an eight-percent reduction** in enterprise wide energy intensity over the previous year. Since becoming an ENERGY STAR partner in 2006, Nissan has saved more than 6.08 trillion British thermal units, equivalent to **the amount of energy needed to drive a Nissan LEAF™ more than 6.35 billion miles**.
