Dear ENERGY STAR® Certification Bodies,

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has released an update to Appendix A of the [Conditions and Criteria for Recognition of Certification Bodies](#). This update clarifies that laboratory recognition may extend to customer test facilities where tests are performed by qualified CB testing laboratory staff and/or local technical representatives, provided that the CB participates in the IEC System of Conformity Assessment Schemes for Electrotechnical Equipment and Components (IECEE) and follows operational document OD-2048 (or current version).
