The Intertape Polymer Corporation (IPG) Danville Facility (Tape) opened in 1987. The facility produces Hot Melt and Acrylic Carton Sealing Tapes. The products manufactured at this site serve an extensive variety of markets including housing, industrial packaging and retail.

IPG's Danville Facility (Tape) achieved the ENERGY STAR Challenge for Industry in 2011 by decreasing its energy intensity by 17.6% within two years. The facility accomplished this achievement by promoting an energy-efficient culture throughout the facility, and through implementing several projects that included the installation of energy-efficient lighting, improving compressed air systems, monitoring combustion equipment, and reinforcing a shut off/turn down program. Overall, IPG Danville Facility (Tape) avoided 6,660 metric tons of carbon.
