Luminous Efficacy and Output Requirements, Source Efficacy.

Exception:

Covered and dimmable versions of GU24 based integrated lamps are required to meet reduced efficacy requirements as outlined in qualification requirements for those lamps.

My comment is please be added language as:

Covered and dimmable versions of GU24 based integrated lamps are required to meet reduced efficacy requirements as outlined in qualification requirements for those lamps. This GU24 based integrated lamps are not able to employing the recessed downlight, attachment light kits of ceiling fan.

On page 24.

1. lamp description, including lamp model number, nominal wattage bulb designation / lamp size (i.e. T4, T5, T8) and lamp base type as defined by ANSI C81.61-2009; or, IEC 60061-1 (i.e. 2G13, GR10q, etc.),

Please be added T3 as (i.e. T3, T4, T5, T8)

Please be correction as (i.e. 2GX13, GR10q, etc.),

On page 44.

For luminaires incorporating non-replaceable ballasts, the above warranty requirement is extended to 5 years.

My comment is please be changed language as following:

For luminaires incorporating non-replaceable ballasts does not included recessed category, the above warranty requirement is extended to 5 years.
