“ENERGY STAR Lamps Specification Framework” Comments

The only comment I would have to add to the specifications would be a requirement that all fluorescent lamp systems (linear and CFLs) be required to have a PF \geq 90%. I recommended this in the last round for CFLs and it was not adopted on a universal basis. The residential requirement is still 55% or higher get the Energy Star rating. This is not acceptable.

This 90% or more must requirement. Otherwise if we converted to 100% CFLs tomorrow for all potential sockets, the electrical grid would burn to the ground. PLEASE ACT ON THIS NOW.
