On the ballast we have the mercury symbol and the mercury statement. Do we need to try to add the "Please Recycle Where Facilities Exist" and that specific website? We currently have the Hg in a circle, Lamp contains Mercury, Dispose according to local, state or Federal laws, along with the website www.lamprecycle.org on our packaging. Will we need to change this to the specific wording that is on the Requirement?
