Everlight Americas appreciates the opportunity to comment on your [January 22, 2010 letter to LED Lamp Stakeholders](#).

We fully support your proposal to revert back to a ≥ 120 Hz requirement. Fluorescent lamps, many used as replacement lamps, have always exhibited a 120 Hz luminous modulation when used on a 60 Hz system. The originally proposed ≥ 150 Hz requirement would require a higher standard for Solid State Lighting and prevent the use of low cost AC LED systems in these products.
