Dear ENERGY STAR[®] Roof Products Partner or Other Industry Stakeholder:

EPA welcomes your input on the attached **Final Draft** ENERGY STAR specification (Version 2.0) for Roof Products. This Final Draft specification addresses the key comments received from stakeholders on the previous Draft 2 document. Specifically, stakeholders will notice the following features of this latest version:

- Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratories' Solar Reflectance Index (SRI) is included as an alternative method for products with thermal emittance levels below 0.75 to meet the specification. SRI is designed to allow lower emittance roofs to qualify if their reflectance levels are high enough above the minimum specification levels to outweigh the impact of lower emittance. An example of how a product can qualify using the SRI is on page 6 of the Final Draft.
- Partners will continue to be required to submit solar reflectance and thermal emittance data in addition to the SRI value for each roof to facilitate the calculation of savings for purchasers.
- EPA continues to allow partners to self-test roof products as with other ENERGY STAR product categories with few exceptions. Self-testing remains a cost effective and efficient way for partners to test and qualify products.
- The proposed effective date has been extended to May 1, 2007 to allow partners approximately 9 months to qualify products under the new specification. EPA's goal is to finalize the specification in August, but even in the event of a delay, May 1, 2007 will continue to be the effective date unless partners raise legitimate concerns about this date.

More details regarding EPA's rationale for proposing these Final Draft requirements are included in note boxes throughout the document.
