

1) **General:**

I noticed that they are planning to remove secondary adders for additional network interfaces. This is good for test labs but may be technically incorrect.

Example: your printer has both wired (Ethernet) and Wireless connections. Per new proposal you connect via Ethernet but do not receive credit (secondary adder) for the wireless. However, the wireless interface is usually always active and consuming power as it looks for networks (I have not encountered a printer where you can disable the wireless function?).
