Summary	Automatic Brightness Control	<p>Two stakeholders agreed with the proposal to drop the 10% allowance for televisions shipping with Automatic Brightness Control enabled and revert to the Version 5.3 test. Several other stakeholders also agreed with the proposed changes but requested that EPA include an additional On Mode test with ABC disabled. They noted that this test could provide data on power consumption when users turn off ABC which could inform future specification revisions.</p> <p>Two of these stakeholders further commented in support of the Sensor Validation Test. One stakeholder also noted that even though the Version 5.3 test at 0 and 300 lux is not representative, providing energy consumption at 10, 50, and 100 lux would provide transparency.</p>	<p>While EPA is interested in data on On Mode power with ABC disabled, in the interest of reducing testing burden, EPA is not requiring this reporting at present. EPA will consider whether such reporting is appropriate for the next revision of the specification.</p>
