

**ENERGY STAR Pool Pump Final Draft Version 1.0 Specification
Stakeholder Written Comment and Response Summary**

Number	Topic	Subtopic	Comment	Response
1	Metric	Motor Efficiency	One respondent recommended that EPA include a reporting requirement for motor efficiency in order to help inform a new metric that is being developed for the CA Title 20 standard. This metric incorporates motor efficiency and is intended to characterize the efficiency of both pool pumps and replacement motors. The respondent asked that the motor efficiency be reported at the highest speed, lowest speed, half speed, and the speed at which the greatest efficiency occurs. They also recommended that IEEE 114-2010 be the referenced test standard.	EPA thanks the respondent for the comments. The test method was finalized on January 15, 2013 and cannot be amended at this time. Motor efficiency is not currently being required because it is not being used as a qualifying metric. EPA is interested in learning more about the metric under development for CA Title 20 and will consider this comment in the next revision of the test method.
2	Test Procedure	Test Speeds	One respondent recommended that EPA update the Test Speeds in Section 5.1 of the Pool Pump Final Test Method to align with the four test speeds outlined in the APSP-15 standard.	EPA thanks the respondent for the comments. The test method was finalized on January 15, 2013 and cannot be amended at this time. The speeds included in the test method are those for which there is either a performance criteria set, or for which it would be helpful for sizing purposes. EPA will consider this comment in the development of the next revision of the test method.
