We have reviewed the first draft of the Program Requirements for Luminaires, Eligibility Criteria-Version 1.0 Draft 1 and believe there are two new requirements that will have an adverse effect on our company.

1. **Warranty**: The draft states that you are seeking parity for warranty requirements. However, there are exceptions to the warranty requirements. Luminaires employing GU24 based integrated lamps and LED light engines which can be manually replaced with a screwdriver are only required to have a two year warranty. This does not achieve parity. You are giving an unfair advantage to certain technologies.

2. **All Luminaires must be shipped with a lamp for each lampholder**: The addition of this specification will require us to obtain and maintain stock levels of the various lamp wattages that may be used in our qualified luminaires. We will also have to revise our packing methods to ensure that the added lamps are not damaged in transit. The maintenance of the lamp inventory and the additional packing requirements will add cost to the end item which will have to be passed along to the consumer. We believe it would be in the best interest of the end user to delete this requirement and maintain the current specification.
