We disagree with section B1C:

We do not think that adding mechanical switches is applicable to disabling any electronic function. It can be done through software by pressing buttons in a special sequence or time to disable something. And that's what we are proposing to disable the energy saver function. We do not agree with adding switches, special tools or removing fronts as this only adds cost and complexity.

We disagree with section D2:

The filter reminder is a small light and we don't see how it bothers someone as there are multiple LED's and displays that are current energized while the unit is running. Having one extra LED doesn't seem to be an issue. We have never received complaints about any of our current displays.

If the issue is enforced again we propose using software by pressing buttons on the electronic control panel to disable this function as it adds no extra cost to any unit.
